The clod is removed by a cut along the shank bone on the elbow side to the shoulder joint and disjointing the shoulder. A cut is made along the medial bone following the second natural seam from the bone on the brisket side of the chuck to remove clod. The clod is trimmed to an average of 1/4" fat cover, bevels, and inside fat.
